NARRATIVE 1	

While on departure out of ZZZ, after the RUUDY6 we were vectored and then cleared direct ELVAE, COL, WHITE, and then as filed. Turning over ELVAE towards COL, ATC asks us if we have been cleared to ELVAE. We confirmed this and then we were told that ATC had issued an update to the fix location and apparently our FMS system was not updated with the new position. ATC informed us we should check the NAV database and check with our company but nothing further was needed on their end. ELVAE in our database was N40 32.77 W074 18.97 but Jeppesen and ATC has it as N40 32.8 W074 16.6. We continued on towards COL and completed the flight uneventful.

SYNOPSIS

Air taxi First Officer reported a waypoint's position in the company database and Jeppesen was different from what ATC provided. ATC had issued an update to the ELVAE fix location but the aircraft's FMS did not contain the updated position nor was the flight crew aware of the update, resulting in a course deviation.
