Problem was that we couldn't find the STAR in our Jepps. We queried Dispatch regarding this. While we were waiting on the response I decided to look at MIA and MIA has the BLUFI4 STAR as part of their Jepps. Dispatch got back to us and basically it appears it's an issue with the Jepp database. The BLUFI4 was line selectable though from our FMS.

Air carrier First Officer reported the BLUFI4 STAR was not found in the Jeppesen database for FLL.
